A laughing Ebisu--the deity of fishermen. Late 19th-century terracotta relief. This is a cast. This popular deity is said to be the ancestor of the Japanese people. He is reputed to be hard of hearing, which is why his devotees make a lot of noise before praying. He is traditionally associated with Daikokuten, the god of Fortune. The patina shows visible signs of wear--chips under the chin and on the right side.
