Small rectangular serving tray in silver-plated metal (20th century) Small rectangular serving tray with rounded corners, made of silver-plated metal. The background features guilloché work with a barleycorn pattern framed by a double geometric frieze and spandrels with stylized foliage. In the center, an oval rocaille cartouche contains an interlaced monogram centered on the letter M. The undulating border is molded and adorned with shells, volutes, and scrollwork in the Louis XV style. The underside rests on four small stamped feet. Late 19th century - early 20th century. Minor scratches from use. On view at Galerie Courcelles Antiquités, at 97 rue de Courcelles, in the 17th arrondissement of Paris.
