### Description

A two-tone brass goblet on a pedestal created by designer and teacher Luc Lanel for the prestigious silverware house Christofle during the Art Deco period (circa 1925-1935). Luc Lanel, the iconic artistic director of Christofle (notably famous for designing the tableware for the ocean liner Normandie), has created here a decorative piece with modernist lines. Crafted from hammered and patinated red/pink copper, enhanced with engraved motifs and nickel silver inlays. The pedestal is made of dark silver-plated metal. Decoration: \* The bowl is adorned with a large central rosette featuring geometric motifs of stylized volutes and arabesques. The flared rim features a wide scalloped border with fluted and striated relief, characteristic of Lanel's Art Deco creations. Signature: Stamped with the Christofle
