Elegant Art Nouveau-era cookie jar, made in France around 1900. The body is made of frosted blown glass, decorated with a delicate polychrome enamel design, accented with gilded foliage. The frame, lid, and hinged handle are made of metal with a naturalistic floral design. The frame bears the Gallia hallmark, while the glasswork is attributed to the Legras & Cie. factory. This piece is representative of French production during the Art Nouveau period, combining the quality of Legras's artistic glass with an elegant, decorative Gallia frame.
