Globe inscribed "Reduced globe based on that of P. Lapie by Lorrain. Bastien the Elder, 60 Rue St André des Arts," circa 1840/Globe made of plaster and embossed paper.Colonel and geographer Pierre Lapie created new maps and globes in the 1820s. These were adapted and modified by Lorrain until the mid-19th century.This globe dates from the 1840s.In good overall condition, although this part of the Northern Hemisphere--particularly Europe--is difficult to read in places.On the base, dealer's mark: "Bellieni à Metz."The globe measures 20 cm in diameter and approximately 47/48 cm in height.
