A large wool tapestry depicting a procession or a romantic horseback ride: this elegant composition features a young woman riding bareback, accompanied by a suitor and attendants, as they ride through a lush green landscape. The vividly colored central scene is highlighted by a floral border; the figures, rendered with finesse, appear to be moving within the natural setting. A work of fine quality, reflecting the craftsmanship of the great historic tapestry workshops. Good overall condition, with normal wear and tear, some damage, previous repairs and restorations, and a few missing sections; the lower portion appears to have been resized. Height 246 cm approx.
