A large, magnificent Louis XIII mirror featuring an inverted profile and marquetry made from native woods (walnut, sycamore, etc.), dating to the 17th century. The various wood species and shades elegantly highlight the lavish ornamentation: flowers, foliage, arabesques, and "dancing" putti adorning two sides. The heart-shaped corner pieces feature rich acanthus leaf motifs. Also notable is the frieze on the outer molding, which alternates between light and
