Description

Four polychrome porcelain sculptural groups depicting allegories of the seasons. They consist of pairs of children in Rococo-style clothing featuring floral motifs and the symbols of the seasons. Model by Johan Carl Schoenheit Meissen, early 20th century. The condition is generally very good. Note that there are some chipped plant motifs--all visible in the photos--in each of the groups, though these are not particularly significant. The Summer group is missing a part of the musical instrument (see photo).
