Nero's mirror. Bottom of a box featuring the reverse side of a Nero sesterce (the lid, which featured the obverse side of the sesterce with the portrait, is missing) and a mirror (which has fused to the inside over time). Bronze. 1st century (after 64). Diameter: 34 mm. 11.85 g. Type II in the typology of Paul-André Besombes, "Les miroirs de Néron" in *Revue Numismatique* n°153, 1998, pp. 119-140. A very rare and charming coin-like object. Provenance : private collection, Lyon, France.
