Description

Oil painting on a beautiful parquet-style oak panel depicting a stormy scene on a North Sea coast. A small boat is bringing a crew ashore, while other sailing vessels are out at sea. The panel is painted in the style of Jan van Goyen (1596-1656), a painter of the Dutch Golden Age. It is difficult to date, as some restorations have been carried out. A red wax seal bearing the initials "CC," affixed after the panel was inlaid, attests to its time in a collection during the 19th century. Scratches, missing areas, and cracks in the panel are visible on the surface. The panel is set in a molded and painted wooden frame from the early 19th century; without the frame, it measures 25.3 x 36.6 cm.
