THE FRONTIERSMEN'S LEGION IS A NATIONALISTIC, CIVILIAN, PARAMILITARY ORGANIZATION FOUNDED IN GREAT BRITAIN IN 1905 BY ROGER POCOCK TO PROTECT THE EMPIRE'S BORDERS BASED IN LONDON, THE LEGION ESTABLISHED BRANCHES THROUGHOUT THE EMPIRE. POST-WORLD WAR II ERA THE JACKET HAS 5 BUTTONS AND 4 POCKETS WITH A STRAIGHT, STAND-UP COLLAR; IT IS DECORATED WITH COLLAR INSIGNIA. EACH SHOULDER IS FITTED WITH CHAIN-MAIL EPAULETS. THE REGULATION PANTS HAVE STRAIGHT LEGS WITH A YELLOW STRIPE RUNNING THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF EACH SIDE. THE TUNIC AND PANTS EACH
