The frame rests on four turned, reeded columns, ending in decorative spherical feet that are sturdy and well-proportioned. The original crank-operated extension mechanism (with a turned wooden crank) is in perfect working order and allows for the insertion of one or more extension leaves, transforming the table from a compact size for everyday use into a spacious dining table seating 8-10 guests.
