Description

Bronze group depicting two putti, one carrying the other on his back. On a blackened wooden base. 19th century. Height of the bronze: 11.4 cm. Total height: 20.8 cm. This group, created by Leonhard Kern circa 1630, enjoyed great success from its creation through the 19th century. Several 17th-century versions are preserved in Germany, including a bronze version at the Liebieghaus in Frankfurt and an ivory version in Hamburg (MKG).
