Capodimonte porcelain (late 19th century)
Capodimonte porcelain pitcher, produced in Naples in the late 19th century, featuring a polychrome molded decoration, partially in relief. The curved body is adorned with a Baroque floral motif: veined leaves, scrolls, and stylized flowers, enhanced with gilding applied by brush. The upper border, highly detailed, features a geometric design alternating between gold fillets and triangular motifs. The handle, molded and clearly defined, displays clean modeling without excessive ornamentation. The color palette--deep pink, enameled green, ivory white, and gold--is characteristic of pieces intended for bourgeois ornamentation of the period, which

avored dense and theatrical decoration. In perfect overall condition: fresh colors, intact decoration, no cracks or visible restoration. The piece displays a beautiful balance of proportions: 16 cm high, 12 cm wide including the handle, upper diameter 6 cm, base 10 cm.
