This lithograph, "Aspects of Nature--Sunset," is signed by Henri Rivière and bears a red stamp in the lower left corner, as well as the publisher's stamp in the lower right corner. Please note that there are some very small, barely visible spots in the sky. We have taken as many photos of the imperfections as possible so that you can assess the condition for yourself. Sold as is. Henri Rivière (1864-1951) was a French painter, printmaker, and illustrator. He began his career with drawing, then moved on to intaglio printmaking--specifically etching--in 1882. At the same time, in 1886, he began a career as a director and set designer for shadow plays at the Cabaret du Chat Noir, enhancing these performances with the creation of highly innovative, colorful sets. He then devoted himself

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exclusively to painting and printmaking, making his mark in the history of etching, printmaking, woodcut, lithography, and watercolor (he painted approximately a thousand watercolors).
