With an immediate formal power, this Kayapo ceremonial club is distinguished by a triangular head with clean, taut lines, extended by a handle entirely sheathed in plant fiber weaving of remarkable density. The radical simplicity of the form--almost minimalist--focuses all attention here on the precision of the proportions, the tension of the volumes, and the quality of the material. Nothing is superfluous: the object commands attention through its very presence. The handle's full-length weaving--a technically demanding process--transcends mere functionality, imbuing

the piece with a dimension of representation and status. The ancient ligatures, some of which are dyed red, contribute to this symbolic significance.
