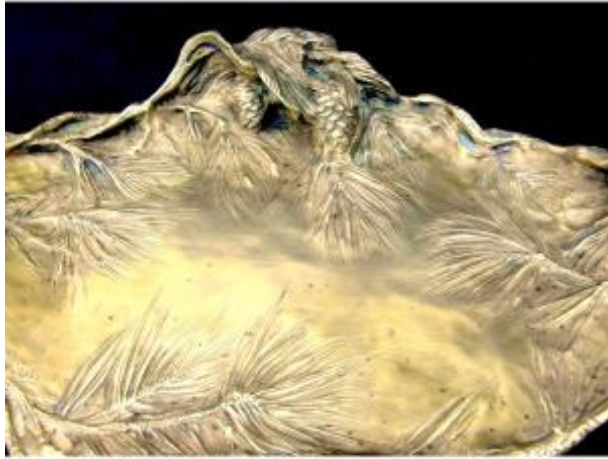




Very Large "pine Cone" Bowl Or Platter In Bronze By A. Marionnet, Circa 1900, Daum Era

Well known among collectors, this very large bowl is typical of the Art Nouveau period, with its curved, asymmetrical shape that superbly mimics nature. The engraving is exquisite, and the craftsmanship is truly exquisite--I'll let you be the judge...Albert Marionnet was a renowned bronze artist of the late 19th century, and his work on desk accessories (money bowls, bowls, inkwells, etc.) is universally acclaimed.
