An elegant portrait depicting a young woman seen in left profile, following a composition rooted in the neoclassical tradition. The subject is portrayed with great simplicity, set against a solid background in shades of gray-green. Her brown hair is carefully pulled back into a bun and held in place by a black velvet headband, while a skillfully drawn curl frames her temple--a detail characteristic of women's fashion from the 1810s to the 1830s. A discreet earring and a delicate necklace reflect a refined taste without ostentation. The ivory satin dress, with puffed sleeves, is embellished with delicate lace trim at the neckline. A pink ribbon tied beneath the bust adds a touch of softness. Please note that the
