Decorated with a scattered pattern of barbel fish, a blue border on the rim, and the monogram "DN" beneath the crown of the Austro-Hungarian Prince (and the Holy Roman Empire). This is likely part of a service commissioned by Franz-Joseph (1767-1854), the eighth prince of that name. The Count of Custine was a shrewd businessman who counted many notable figures among his clients, including, notably, George Washington. Condition report:
