Description

Part of a French porcelain coffee service - Louis Philippe period, mid-19th century An elegant part of a tea service made of fine French porcelain dating from the Louis Philippe period (1830-1848), a refined example of mid-19th-century decorative art. The set consists of four coffee cups with matching saucers, a coffee pot with a lid, a sugar bowl with a lid, and a creamer. The set is distinguished by its rich, hand-painted polychrome decoration featuring floral motifs in vibrant shades of orange, green, and purple, embellished with delicate gilded vines and small stylized fruits. The abundant gilding--found on the rims, inside the cups, on the handles, and on the details of the various forms--lends the set an elegance typical of French production from that period. The faceted shapes

of the coffee pot, sugar bowl, and creamer, combined with the sculpted knobs on the lids and the finely modeled handles, reflect the understated yet refined taste characteristic of the Louis Philippe era. The condition is very good, with normal and slight wear on the gilding consistent with its age and use. There are no significant chips or obvious restorations.
