Description

Oil on canvas depicting an elegant portrait of a woman painted in the 1930s. The subject, shown in a half-length portrait, stands out against a dark background rendered with a free and vibrant brushstroke. The face, with its delicate features and melancholic gaze, is highlighted by a refined palette in which the luminous skin tones contrast with the deep blue dress that reveals her shoulders. The work displays a sensitive style characteristic of interwar portrait painting, prioritizing the subject's expression over academic precision. The paint is applied spontaneously and reveals a true sense of light. On the reverse, the painting bears a handwritten attribution to Ethel Walker (1861-1951), a prominent Scottish painter, whose name is inscribed on the stretcher. A recognized figure in

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early 20th-century British art, Ethel Walker was a leading portraitist and figure painter.
