Description

An 18th-century oval portrait of a lady of quality, featuring a powdered hairstyle adorned with a string of pearls, a light-colored silk bodice in the French style decorated with roses, and a dark mantle draped over the shoulders. It is characteristic of the French school of the third quarter of the 18th century. The brushwork is soft and slightly naive, suggesting a talented provincial painter working in the spirit of Perronneau or Duplessis; the oval format was highly fashionable for intimate portraits of the period. The original gilded wood frame features a pattern of fluting and crossed, knotted ribbons, with an inner bead-and-reel molding.
