I am a Figurative but not a Naturalist , which allows me to nuance the details , erase them or accentuate them according to the subject and the material ».It is essentially from the earth that the sculptures of Jean-François Leroy are born .A bit of straight cutting at times , but time is no match for that .It is therefore most often the clay that is modeled then chiseled , sanded and smoothed according to its hygrometry and the progress of the work . Precarious balance , fragility of matter .When it comes to making a bronze , many technical steps that he masters will follow one another in his workshop .Apart from the casting entrusted to his founder , he makes moulds , waxes , welds , carvings , polishings , patinas .Designer for the Baccarat and Daum crystal works and the Odier goldsmith house .
