This raised lid with a flat roof is of medieval inspiration; Toulouse is the only center to have preserved this style in the 18th centuryThese pitchers served as wine measures during the Ancien Régime. The capacity of those used in inns, taverns, etc., had to be periodically inspected by royal or ecclesiastical authorities to ensure "fair measure" for the consumer.In Toulouse, the regulations of
