### Description

Complete Neo-Basque bedroom set by Maison Souyeux, Nay, 1958, bleached blond oak with red fabric. A beautiful Neo-Basque-style bedroom set, crafted in 1958 by Maison Souyeux, a furniture manufacturer based in Nay in the Basses-Pyrénées, now known as Pyrénées-Atlantiques. This coordinated set includes a large wedding wardrobe, a bed, two nightstands, and a matching chair. It is a testament to the regionalist furniture produced in Béarn and the Basque Country during the 1950s, when local workshops combined traditional regional forms with comfortable furniture designed for modern postwar interiors. The wardrobe, the centerpiece of the bedroom, features a grand, architecturally designed front made of light oak. It opens with three doors and is

distinguished by its panels deeply carved with four facing hearts, its stylized rosettes, and its upper crossbar adorned with foliage, flowers, and a central fleur-de-lis. The upper sections of the side doors feature openwork with turned balusters set against a red fabric background, creating a decorative contrast with the light oak. The design of the wardrobe draws on the tradition of Basque and Béarn wedding wardrobes, pieces of furniture traditionally crafted to mark the establishment of a new household. The decoration combines floral motifs, rosettes, geometric carvings, and turned elements in a regionalist style characteristic of the 1950s. The bed, the two nightstands, and the chair are crafted from the same light oak and feature the same decorative style. The chair features a high backrest upholstered in a red fabric with a small pattern, button-tufted and accented with decorative nails. The nightstands are also carved and feature a drawer as well as lower storage space. The set thus maintains a true unity of design, material, and color. Today, the wood has a blond, whitewashed tone that highlights the carvings and the oak's grain. The red fabric is reminiscent of Basque textiles and adds a warm touch to the set. This bedroom set would be well-suited for a Basque home, a country house, a chalet, a guesthouse, or a contemporary interior seeking authentic regional French furniture.
