Dimensions: 46 cm x 37 cm without frame and 57 cm x 67 cm. Magnificent gilded and carved wooden frame. Elisabeth was born in 1670 at Barrowby Hall in Lincolnshire. The daughter of Arthur Ingram and Jane Mallory, she married Astrophus Danby and became the grandmother of Mary, Countess of Harcourt. With delicacy and elegance, Elisabeth Ingram presents herself to us in a three-quarter-length portrait, her gaze gentle and direct. Dressed in a white silk gown accented by a blue cloak, her dignified presence captivates us.
