A stunning Reyhanli gallery/corridor piece from southeastern Anatolia. It is actually a single section of a kilim; it is referred to as a fragment. A fragment, certainly, but one of great beauty. Masterfully woven wool-on-wool. The weaving is exceptionally fine. The limits of what is possible with wool have been pushed. Refinement and delicacy abound. Usually, this is precisely the type of piece one admires in museums, in specialized magazines, or in the collections of private collectors. Exclusively plant-based dyes, deep and luminous. In perfect harmony. Shades of pomegranate red, wine red, deep indigo, raspberry, saffron-tinged ochre, and ivory.
