PLACE DE LA CONCORDE, oil on canvas, signed lower left: HenryMALFROY Charles Henri Malfroy (1895-1945) was a French painter; He exhibited regularly in Paris at the Salon des Artistes Français and the Salon desIndépendants until 1934.Adopting a technique similar to Impressionism, he painted the coastlines andports of the Bouches-du-Rhône and Var regions, as well as landscapes of Paris and thebanks of the Seine.His work was part of the painting event in the art competitionat the 1928 Summer Olympics. A member of the French Resistanceduring World War II, Malfroy was arrested and died at theBuchenwald concentration camp.] He was posthumously awarded the Order ofLiberation. This large-format paintingdepicts an iconic Parisianscene, featuring pedestrians, vintage
