A large drop-down panel reveals a rosewood-veneered compartment consisting of six drawers and six open compartments, with a top covered in red leather adorned with gold-embossed friezes. In the lower section, two doors provide access to two drawers and a shelf, as well as a removable safe with its original lock and key.
