engraved with bundles of weapons; signed
GABRIEL ALGORA MD and dated 1734;
stamped with "GLEALGORA" surmounted by a
crown. Hammer, bassinet, and bassinet cover
engraved as a set. Walnut stock, engraved with a
seashell. Counterplate made of cut and openwork
