Description A George II sterling silver chocolate pot, Sebastian & James Crespell, London, 1774The body, of elegant proportions and raised on a high stepped circular foot, is of graceful baluster form with rounded shoulders and a tapering neck, terminating in a shaped spout of sinuous profile. The hinged cover is surmounted by a finely chased pinecone finial. The surface is enriched with a delicate ornamental scheme comprising suspended laurel swags between circular rosette medallions.
