She stands holding a rifle in her right hand and, in her left hand, a scroll and olive branches bearing the dates of the revolutions of 1789 and 1830. She steps on a broken chain, with a pedestal behind her on which rests a level marked "Liberte, Fraternite." The main face is engraved "LIBERTE, LIBERTE CHERIE, COMBATS AVEC TES DEFENSEURS" Signed on the tip "DAVID D'ANGERS 1840" A rare signed and dated example in perfect original condition. Height: 23.5 cm, Base 7 cm x 7 cm Founder stamp "Thiebaut Freres" in Paris Date: 1840 Perfect condition Pierre-Jean David d'Angers 1788 - 1856 Sculptor and engraver, he sculpted the ornamentation of the Arc de Triomphe, the Carrousel, and the frieze of the Louvre Palace.
