A pair of crystal vases from the prestigious Saint-Louis crystalworks, crafted around 1900, at the height of the Art Nouveau period. Blown from satin-finish crystal, these vases feature a finely acid-etched design, enhanced by rich gold gilding depicting dragonflies in flight, delicate foliage, and wildflowers. This naturalistic design, emblematic of Art Nouveau, is executed with remarkable finesse, with the dragonflies' wings elegantly catching the light. The background is enriched with a polychrome interlayered design composed of glass powder inclusions in shades of coral red, brown, and white, creating a subtle marbled effect that lends depth and luminosity to the piece as a whole. This pair perfectly illustrates the exceptional craftsmanship of the Saint-Louis crystalworks, combining blown crystal, acid
