Bust of the painter Albert Bonnard, in bronze with a nuanced brown patina, by Paul Paulin (1852-1937), signed and dedicated to Charles Tisseyre (1880-1944), a French art historian. Lost-wax foundry mark: AA Hebrard. Paul Paulin was a dentist by profession who became an accomplished sculptor, nicknamed "the sculptor of the Impressionists." He was noticed by Degas and became a leading portraitist of his time. Notable among his works are the busts of Renoir, Monet, Pissarro, and Rodin.
