Description

An important plaster cast from the late 19th century, a full-scale reproduction of the Virgin known as the "Virgin of Nozé" by the Angers artist Pierre Biardeau (1608-1671). The original work was created in terracotta around 1660 and is currently on display at the Saint-Martin Collegiate Church in Angers (photo 8). It has been listed as a Historic Monument since February 15, 2000. Until the mid-1950s, our model was on display at the Lycée David in Angers. A plaque from the Chapeau workshop is affixed to the base; in the 19th century, the Chapeau workshop was a studio in Angers specializing in the reproduction of religious sculptures.
