Description

Elegant vase made of black hyalite glass (or black opaline), featuring a geometric, stylized design delicately etched or sandblasted. The design is crisp, even, and perfectly symmetrical--a fine example of quality craftsmanship. Geometric floral motifs typical of Art Deco, with a matte finish contrasting with the glossy background--a combination of understated elegance and black/matte contrast that was highly sought after at the time. Beautiful ovoid shape with a short cylindrical neck. Very good overall condition, no visible chips. A understated and refined decorative piece, ideal for an Art Deco or contemporary interior. Unsigned, Master glassmaker Jean Luce created an identical piece (see last photo) with the same dimensions! The absence of a signature implies that this is either
