Stunning and unique, large lidded pot, a RAKU-glazed stoneware vase in polychrome colors, resting on four small, ornate feet. Sculptural, almost anthropomorphic, imposing and very decorative, with a beautiful textural effect and a brutalist aesthetic: The piece features polychromatic colors combining blue, turquoise, ochre, and terracotta glazes. Handcrafted, one-of-a-kind piece, created by a contemporary ceramic artist, with wabi-sabi influences (signature unidentified). Its flattened silhouette, abstract geometric reliefs, and lid make it a unique and sculptural decorative art object. signed on one side Technique Clay with a high chamotte content, intentionally rough texture. Assembled from slabs (coil-building technique/visible slabs) Structural crackling intentionally
