Description

This piece is a porcelain planter by Jacob Petit (circa 1840-1860) with a flared shape, richly decorated with a purple background accented with gilding, featuring a central cartouche depicting a pastoral scene. The exuberant decoration is characteristic of Jacob Petit's work. The presence of the inner reservoir is a real asset, as it has often been lost over time. A complete Jacob Petit planter with its reservoir is significantly more sought after by collectors and may command a higher value than an incomplete example. Condition: very good overall condition; normal wear on the gilding.
