A fine plaster sculpture from a plaster cast gallery depicting a seated Moses, inspired by one of the masterpieces of Renaissance art, Michelangelo's Moses, created in the 16th century for the funerary monument of Julius II and now housed in the Basilica of San Pietro in Vincoli in Rome. The patriarch is depicted in a solemn and contemplative pose, with his characteristic long, flowing beard, and holding the Tablets of the Law, a symbol of biblical revelation, in his right hand. The statue features a pleasant natural patina that enhances its charm. The original workmanship opening is visible on the bottom. Datable to the early 20th century.
