Description

A large carved wooden rooster, a piece of folk art likely created in the late 19th or early 20th century. A large-scale sculpture entirely carved with a gouge, the marks of which are still clearly visible on the base. Original polychrome paint remains in places, particularly on the crest and wattles. Height 58 cm - base 30 x 24 cm - weight 10.2 kg. In good overall condition with normal signs of wear, natural cracks in the wood, and the tip of the tail missing.
