He specialized in tableware such as salt cellars, oil cruets, bowls, and candy dishes... Our candy dish features a cut-glass bowl adorned with a pattern of shields and points reminiscent of the craftsmanship of the Creusot factory. Its solid silver mount is characterized by rich, delicately chiseled decoration; its crown-shaped handle rests on a bed of foliage, and its handles are particularly elaborately crafted with lions. It rests on a pedestal with a square base and lion's paws. The piece is embellished with rows of pearls and water leaves... Gross weight: 872 grams. Good
