### Description

At the top, it features a drawer adorned with a round pull knob--discreet yet elegant--that reflects the refined simplicity characteristic of this period. Just below, a niche closed by a sliding curtain adds a functional touch, reminiscent of the small writing desks and occasional furniture of the 19th century. The lower section opens to a storage area equipped with an adjustable shelf on a rail system, allowing the interior to be adapted as needed while maintaining the piece's refined aesthetic. Two slender columns on either side of the front elegantly frame the piece, like delicate pillars that lend it verticality and character. The
