Original gilding (in some photos, there are slight variations in color. This is due to the photography and the lighting being on). Louis XV style. Date: Late 19th century. New lampshade custom-made by me. This is actually one of a pair of candlesticks that may be sold together in another listing. (They feature different lampshades to distinguish them, but the green lampshades from the pair are also available with the candlesticks sold separately.)
