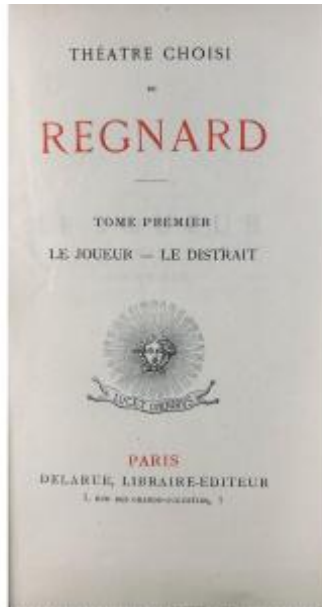

Jean-François Regnard, a French writer and playwright of the second half of the 17th century, was considered the finest comic playwright after Molière. Regnard led an eventful life; he was an epicurean and an inveterate gambler. He traveled extensively and was even taken as a slave in Algiers before being ransomed.
