### Description

- Solid silver pocket watch, chiseled and guilloché, decorated with a scene of a hare hunt.- Rectangular Swiss fineness mark with the numbers 0.900 engraved insideinside the hallmark in a rectangle, expressed as 900/1000 in thousandths for the purity of the solid silver in use in Switzerland, present on the case and the dust cover. - The number 1888 of the pocket watch case engraved in intaglio on the case back and the dust cover, and the name J. Geiger, the owner of the pocket watch, engraved in intaglio on the case back. - Chiseled and guilloché-engraved dust cover with the inscriptions: straight-line anchor, 17 jewels, visible Breguet spiral, white balance wheel with four balance cock settings. - Smooth bezel of the solid silver dust cover on a hinge and mineral

glass protecting the movement of the pocket watch. - Case back, chiseled and guilloché, depicting a hare-hunting scene with two hunters under a tree; one is kneeling and hidden behind a wooden fence and vegetation, firing at the hare being chased by his dog, the other holding a hunting trumpet in his right hand and his rifle resting on the ground in his left hand. - Solid silver lugs, notched winding crown in copper-plated metal, slightly domed and beveled mineral glass. - White enamel dial, Roman numerals for the hours and Arabic numerals for the minutes, black-painted railway-style minute track, Louis XV-style hands in gilded metal set with rose-cut Rhine stones. - Small seconds sub-dial at six o'clock, Arabic numerals for the seconds, black-painted railway-style minute track, and a blued steel seconds hand. - Guilloché movement in polished steel set with 17 jewels, featuring a straight-line anchor escapement, visible escape wheels, and a Breguet balance spring, compensated balance wheel, four jewel settings, ratchet screw, ratchet pawl, and a polished steel advance and retard lever located above the balance wheel. - Winding via the pendant; the time is set by pressing the small push button located at the top left next to the head of the pendant and simultaneously turning the winding mechanism clockwise. - In perfect working condition, serviced by a watchmaker. - Date: last quarter of the 19th century, circa 1890-1900. - Gross weight: 114 gr. - Reminder to buyers regarding the right of withdrawal for online purchases on my Proantic website.- Must be read before purchasing on my Proantic hosted sales site.- The right of withdrawal applies to sales made on my Proantic sales site. - The withdrawal period is 14 days following the buyer's receipt of the item or goods. - The buyer must notify me via email or by certified mail, without needing to provide a justification or reason, before the 14 day period provided by law following receipt of the package or item.- The buyer has the right to change their mind and

has a 14-business-day cooling-off period as provided by this right of withdrawal law, and I respect this right. - After this period, the sale will be considered final and binding. - The costs of returning the item by mail or through a carrier are the buyer's responsibility in the event of withdrawal by the buyer. - The buyer is required to return the item within 14 days of receiving the item or package in its original condition as received, without any breakage or damage to the item and in the same packaging in which it was received, with the same shipping costs and with insurance for the item covering the full sale price listed on my Proantic website, as arranged by the seller, and must provide me via email with the proof-of-deposit receipt issued by the post office when the package or item was dropped off at the post office, or the waybill issued by the carrier.- All sales made on my Proantic website are covered by insurance purchased from La Poste at the time the item or package is shipped, covering loss or theft up to the purchase price paid by the buyer. - La Poste does not cover breakage or damage to the item or object; only theft and loss are covered for package shipping.- Additional insurance covering breakage of the item, up to the price paid by the buyer on my Proantic website, is always purchased from the carrier if the item is shipped by them. - The buyer is subject to legal penalties if they do not return the item within this 14-day period and in good condition.- A refund for the item will be issued within 14 days of the seller's receipt of the item or package and after the condition of the item has been verified. - If the item or product is found not to be in its original condition, the sale will be considered final with no refund, and the right of withdrawal cannot be exercised. - The refund for the item or product will be issued via the same payment method (check, bank transfer, PayPal) that the buyer used when making the purchase on my Proantic sales site.- The buyer must take the necessary steps on PayPal themselves to

request a refund if they paid via PayPal,  
specifically by going to the Disputes section  
and opening a dispute case involving themselves,  
PayPal, and the seller.- This reminder regarding  
sales on my Proantic store is intended for litigious  
individuals and those acting in bad faith. - I  
advise litigious individuals and those acting in  
bad faith not to purchase anything from my  
Proantic store; this will prevent me from  
wasting my time and money on legal  
proceedings. - Fortunately, most of the time my  
sales on the Proantic site go very smoothly, with  
customers who are generally friendly, pleasant,
