Description

Important patinated antimony table clock from the 19th/20th century, embellished with a striking allegorical composition in the neoclassical style depicting a female figure associated with the marine world. The sculpture, characterized by elegant drapery and refined modeling, is depicted holding a trident, while at her feet unfolds a rich marine iconography featuring a dolphin emerging from an amphora. Next to the figure stands the clock mechanism, adorned with a circular dial featuring enameled Roman numerals, surmounted by a globe that contributes to the composition's balance. The finely crafted base is adorned with volutes, plant motifs, and classically inspired ornamental details, which lend the piece a striking decorative impact. The dark antimony patina enhances the quality of the casting and

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highlights the richness of the sculptural details, making this clock an important piece of furniture as well as a fascinating collector's item. Thanks to its substantial dimensions, the piece is well-suited for placement on a console table, a sideboard, or a formal table, becoming the focal point of the room. The clock retains its original dial with enameled Roman numerals and its period mechanical movement, visible from the back.

Condition The piece is in good condition, with a pleasing patina consistent with its age. As visible in the photographs, there are some missing decorative elements, as well as normal signs of age and use that do not compromise its decorative value. The movement is present but has not been serviced.
