Description

19th-century French school; oil on wood depicting the scene of Charlotte Corday's arrest, which took place just after the assassination of Marat on July 13, 1793. Charlotte Corday, a staunch royalist, appears impassive and almost smiling, surrounded by bloodthirsty revolutionaries. In excellent condition. This painting is an early replica of the famous work by Ary Scheffer, painted in 1830 and exhibited at the 1831 Salon. This painting is now housed at the Lambinet Museum. Ary Scheffer, 1795-1858, an eminent genre painter of the first half of the 19th century. The painting is presented in its original, attractive frame of gilded wood and stucco (minor signs of wear). Dimensions: 33 x 38 cm. Panel dimensions: 19.5 x 15.5 cm. Work from the first half of the 19th century.

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
