This is one of five figures modeled by Paul Scheurich in 1913 based on the Russian ballet \*Carnival\*. The ballet was choreographed in Saint Petersburg in 1910 by Mikhail Fokin to Robert Schumann's piano music and was performed in Berlin by Sergei Diaghilev's ballet company--a performance that had deeply impressed Scheurich.
