Maurice JALLOT, born in 1900, son of Léon JALLOT, a French cabinetmaker and interior designer, and Léon Drivier, a French sculptor. Rare black-lacquered sideboard with two front doors, lower crossbar accented by a gilded bronze molding, saber-shaped legs characteristic of Maurice Jallot's work with gilded bronze plates at the top, mahogany interior featuring a central shelf. Gilded bronze keyhole. Magnificent ornamentation featuring two gilded bronze pieces on the theme of music, created by Léon Drivier, a French sculptor and collaborator of Maurice Jallot.
