A large beveled mirror, known as a "trumeau," in the Henri II style. Missing silver plating at the bottom, and more lightly in places on the mirror. Period: 19th. Dimensions: height 200 cm, width at the bottom 90 cm, width at the top 102 cm; weight approximately 30 kg. Good condition.
